CLIFFS OF MOHER

- Sea cliffs
- In County Clare, Ireland
- 14 kilometres long, 214 metres height
- Name from an old promontory fort called *Mothar* or *Moher*
- Appear in Harry Potter film
- Is accessible by the Bus Éireann



CONNEMARA

- National park
- West of Ireland (Galway)
- Is made up of multiple peninsulas
- Ó Cadhla clan, rulers of Connemara, 13th century
- Accessible by the Bus Éireann and City Link



GALWAY

- Is a city in the West of Ireland in the province of Connacht.
- Galway lies in the River Corrib.
- Is populous in Ireland.
- The most interesting of Galway.
- The name comes from The Irish name “Gaillimhe”.
